Quality Education

ECD support for fenceline communities:

- ✓ Free State, Gauteng, KZN, Limpopo, Mpumalanga
- ✓ 12 800 children reached to date
- ✓ 334 ECD centres supported
- ✓ 729 Practitioners
- ✓ 193 Managers
- ✓ Launch of digital skills and training of 15 practitioners as a pilot
- ✓ Practitioners are improving their qualifications by acquiring NQF level 4 training for completion in May.
- ✓ Launch of literacy programme in partnership with SA Institute for Distance Education with all 7 implementing partners.

STEM in schools

Coding and Robotics

- 40** teachers were trained in Mpumalanga.
- 30** learners participated in robotics competition in Free State.

Mobile Laboratories

- ✓ 43 schools supported.

Teacher Training and Capacity Development

- ✓ Engagements with DBE on a maths teacher development national programme are underway

Tertiary Programme

- 78** new bursaries were awarded for 2025 academic year for undergraduate and post graduate studies.

50% funding support

Technical Education

- MoU signed** in Mpumalanga for 4IR laboratories to be established at the TVET college.
- ✓ **529** teachers are training on Computer Aided Design for digital engineering drawings from all 9 provinces.
- ✓ **Engagements** with Department of Higher Education and Training on the TTTI.



Handyman Services

Graduation was held in Secunda where **8 learners** completed their work integrated learning.



Solar PV Programme

92 beneficiaries have completed training from Sasolburg and Ekandustria. **15** SMME's have been incubated to date.



Motor Mechanics Programme

1 learner is certified as a qualified artisan, the rest are awaiting workplace integration



Welding Skill Programme

All **18 learners** were employed during the Sasol shutdown in 2024 (July to October).



Business Digital Services

- ✓ **85** candidates certified in AI, Data Science, Software Dev or Drone Piloting
- ✓ **14** candidates have drone licences
- ✓ **R6.1 million** raised for entrepreneurs
- ✓ **8** candidates received jobs
- ✓ **13** active businesses

Community Development

- ✓ **35** beneficiaries currently reside at the refurbished safe houses in Sasolburg and Secunda, providing them with a safe environment after being victims of GBVF.
- ✓ **2 mobile units** have been completed to mobilise communities on GBVF support and care information around the Energy retail businesses reaching over 1000 people in KZN and Gauteng.



Sasol For Good
