\$300,000 FOR THE FIRST BEACH SOCCER AFRICAN CUP OF NATIONS IN MOZAMBIQUE

With an investment of \$300,000, Sasol enabled the construction of the Vilankulo Arena, a key facility for hosting the Beach Soccer African Cup of Nations in 2022. The tournament, which featured the continent's elite national teams, generated a multidimensional impact: it promoted sporting excellence, boosted local trade and established Vilankulo as a leading tourist destination.

The project was carried out in close collaboration with the Vilankulo City Council and the Mozambican Football Federation.

THE INHASSORO MARATHON A LEGACY FOR ATHLETICS IN INHAMBANE

Over the past three years, the streets of Inhassoro have been transformed into a vibrant sea of blue and white to host the Inhassoro Mile. Since its inception in 2023, this prestigious event has attracted approximately 1,500 athletes annually, cementing its status as a cornerstone of the village's anniversary celebrations.

The race serves as a regional hub for talent, drawing competitors not only from local districts and neighboring provinces but also from across borders, including Zimbabwe and South Africa.

With funding from Sasol in Mozambique, technical support from the Mozambican Athletics Federation and local authorities, the initiative goes far beyond the sporting competition. The programme culminates in the presentation of prizes to the overall winners of the men's and women's categories and a musical performance. More than just a race, the Inhassoro League is a driver of economic growth and a symbol of pride and identity for the community.

OVER MZN 38 MILLION METICAIS FOR BASKETBALL OVER THE LAST FIVE YEARS

Sasol has cemented its position as the leading driving force behind women's basketball in Mozambique by sponsoring the last five editions of the Sasol League (National Senior Women's Basketball Championship) in partnership with the Mozambican Basketball League (LMB), the body responsible for organizing the top-tier competition.

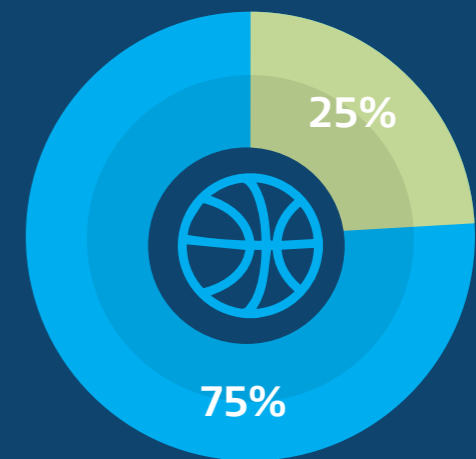
This successful journey began with an investment of 24 million Meticaís (around 360,000 US dollars) for the seasons between 2021 and 2023, laying the foundations for the growth of the sport in the country.

Considering the positive results from the first three seasons, Sasol renewed the partnership in 2024 for a further two years, with a value of 14,750,000 MT. Under the terms of the memorandum of understanding between Sasol and LMB, 25% of the amount, approximately 30,000 US dollars, is to be invested in basketball development projects in Inhambane Province.

More than just supporting sports, this sponsorship has a strong social component, ensuring that local talent has the necessary resources to shine.

BOOSTING BASKETBALL IN INHAMBANE FROM THE GRASSROOTS UP

The expansion of basketball in Inhambane Province has gained new momentum thanks to funding from Sasol, in partnership with the Mozambican Basketball League (LMB), in collaboration with the Inhambane Provincial Basketball Association and district authorities. Under the agreement with the LMB, 25% of the annual budget is allocated to Inhambane Province, to be spent on institutional development initiatives, the purchase of sports equipment and materials, the payment of referees' fees, technical training and the development of basketball x in the districts of Inhassoro, Govuro and Vilankulo, areas where Sasol operates.

This initiative involves young people, with equal representation of boys and girls, in a competition that reaffirms the commitment to sporting inclusion and the promotion of a healthy lifestyle within communities.

NATIONAL SCHOOL SPORTS GAMES FESTIVAL: BOOSTING SCHOOL SPORT

Sasol has supported the Inhambane delegation at the National School Sports Games Festival. At the 2024 edition, held in May in Nampula province, the company provided the full sports kit (uniforms and additional equipment) for the provincial team.

This ongoing investment aims to strengthen the foundations of Mozambican sport and promote healthy lifestyles among young people.



TOFO SURF SERIES: WAVES OF OPPORTUNITY IN INHAMBANE

Since 2022, the iconic Tofo Beach has become the epicenter of national surfing with the launch of the Tofo Surf Series. This initiative by the Boardriders Association, which has enjoyed strategic sponsorship from Sasol since its inception, brings together around 100 surfers annually across seven categories.


More than just a competition, the tournament is a driving force for boosting tourism and promoting healthy lifestyles, offering young local talent the ideal platform to shine in the waters of Inhambane.






KIT FOR 51 FOOTBALL TEAMS IN GOVURO AND INHASSORO

In total, 22 teams from the Recreational Championship — representing all the communities in these districts — were kitted out with professional kits. The investment benefited teams from the Govuro and Inhassoro District Recreational Championships, covering all local communities. Each kit delivered was designed to be self-sufficient, ranging from shirts and goalkeeper gloves to stopwatches and whistles, strengthening the infrastructure of community sport and team spirit in the region.

INVESTMENT IN THE CONSTRUCTION OF 6 NEW FACILITIES

This development is a direct result of the Local Development Agreements (LDAs), under the Corporate Social Responsibility Policy for the Extractive Industry, where the governance model ensures that beneficiary communities have the power to set priorities.

In this tripartite dialogue between communities, district governments and Sasol, the community identified sport as a central pillar for human development and social cohesion.

Through significant investment in the construction of modern infrastructure, Inhambane Province now boasts decent facilities for sporting activities, transforming dirt pitches into well-structured venues that are a source of pride for local communities.

This infrastructure expansion plan ensures that talent discovered in school and recreational competitions has a top-class venue in which to develop. In this context, the following have been built.

RENOVATION OF VILANKULO MUNICIPAL STADIUM

Thanks to funding from Sasol, Vilankulo Municipal Football Stadium will soon undergo renovation work. The project is expected to restore the stadium to a condition suitable for playing football and enable local teams to play their home matches again with dignity and safety.

The refurbishment of the stadium is one of the priorities of the Local Development Agreements II. With a capacity of 5,000 spectators, the Vilankulo Municipal Stadium, built in 2006 with funding from Sasol, is the largest sports facility in Inhambane Province and serves as the home ground for local teams in national and provincial competitions, notably the Moçambola and the Mozambique Cup.
